On behalf of the Board of Directors, I want to express our sincere gratitude to the entire Trinity Services staff for a remarkable 2022. This past year brought some very significant wins for the organization.

First, I want to thank everyone for your generous donations to Trinity Services in 2022. Your gifts help Trinity provide the highest quality person-directed services and supports to people with disabilities and mental health needs so they may flourish. Your continuous support makes this entirely possible.

In the spring of 2022, Trinity Services celebrated the grand opening of *Studio 22*, converting a former Trinity warehouse into a modern recording studio and space for community day pursuits such as playing musical instruments, tending hydroponic plants, and engaging in therapeutic activities like yoga. It is truly a remarkable space.

This past summer, Trinity unveiled *Prairie Trail at the Landings*, a new residential apartment complex in New Lenox featuring 22 one-bedroom and 3 three-bedroom units, each with its own kitchen, bathroom, living space and storage area. The project was a cooperative venture

between Trinity Services, the Illinois Department of Housing Authority and the Village of New Lenox. A job well done!

In October, Trinity was the recipient of a 2022 Council on Quality and Leadership (CQL) Award of Excellence. The award celebrated the collaboration between Trinity Services and the Orland Park police department to provide community mental health supports, provide training for clinicians and law enforcement officers and establish Mobile Crisis Response Units (MCRU) to respond to emergencies. Congratulations to Bonnie Hassan, Director of Out-patient Services for Trinity, and her team.

Finally, I want to recognize our President and CEO, Thane Dykstra, Ph.D., for his appointment to the Council on Quality and Leadership Board of Directors. Thane's wealth of knowledge and expertise truly embody CQL's values and he is a great fit for the organization.

# Someone You Should Know

Shell Jones, DSP



*"You need to see the world from their point of view!"*

-- Shell Jones

When you first meet Shell Jones, a Direct Support Person with Trinity Services, her infectious smile and effervescent personality radiate across the room. However, behind the smile and the personality is a dedicated individual with a wonderful sense of humor. One thing is certain. Shell is a real people person. This delightful woman loves life!

Shell's relationship with Trinity Services started back in 2010 when she brought her niece in to apply for a job at Trinity. Since she was there, Shell decided to apply as well. The next day, she received a phone call from Trinity and her journey began. This year marks 13 years with Trinity Services.

"I have always been interested in helping others," said Shell, who was babysitting four kids at the age of fourteen. "The people at Trinity seemed very nice and working in behavioral health seemed like quite a challenge. So I thought I'd give it a try."

Shell began working the night shift in one of the residential homes that

housed six women, all with different behavioral issues. Shell quickly discovered two things. First, she had a lot to learn about assisting people with behavioral health needs. Second, she really enjoyed the challenge.

"It took a while for me to figure out the most effective ways to support these people," said Shell. "Most importantly, I needed to learn the behavioral triggers, the stimuli that impacts a person's behaviors." The extensive training Shell received at Trinity really helped her better understand the actions or situations that would cause someone to have an emotional reaction. Over time, she learned to apply her training to solve issues.

"It took some time before I realized that the methods we were being taught actually worked," explained Shell. "One day, two guys got into a disagreement and I used my training to stop the altercation and solve the problem. Then I thought, maybe Trinity's on to something!"

One of the things that helped Shell prepare for her role as a DSP was

raising five children. "Raising five children will teach you all about patience," said Shell, "which is what you need to do this job."

Working at Trinity has taught Shell a lot and she has definitely grown from experience. "You have to learn patience," explained Shell. "Sometimes the best thing is to just sit back, listen, observe, and just wait it out. To be effective at your job, you have to see things from their point of view."

Shell loves to cook and never misses an opportunity to serve a tasty meal. One of the things Shell loves about her job are the holidays. "I cook every Sunday and every holiday, even on my off days," said Shell with a smile. "I make it my business to be sure these wonderful folks feel the love of the holiday, to make sure they know someone cares about them."

Christmas is her favorite holiday of the year. "I decorate the house inside and out, cook a delicious meal, and make sure everyone is feeling good. Just imagine if you were sitting home alone for the holidays? How would you feel? It's the holidays!"

Another favorite holiday is Memorial Day. “I have one gentleman who loves to barbecue,” said Shell. “He looks forward to this every year. I prepare the meat and he cooks everything for the group. It’s a wonderful shared experience!”

Sometimes, Shell finds herself making meals on days even when she’s not scheduled to cook. “Everyone appreciates what I do,” said Shell. “They always say thank you!”

Shell suffers from congestive heart failure - when the heart muscle doesn’t pump blood as well as it should. This serious health issue has taught her not to stress over things for which she has no control. “I don’t do negativity,” said Shell. “I’ve learned to take life as it comes. I always maintain a positive attitude.”

Given her health situation, Shell also makes sure to take time for herself. “I always take the time to do self-care,” said Shell. “When I’m off, I’m off. I just relax. I’ll go get a manicure, read a book, watch one of my favorite shows or treat myself to a nice lunch!”

“I love Trinity, I love my Trinity family, and I love my job,” said Shell. “It’s all about coming to work and seeing that all of the men and women we serve are happy. If I can brighten their day with a smile or a kind word, that means the world to me.”
